



Greater Minnesota's Premier Retail Center

Greater Mankato is a destination for retail shopping in southern Minnesota. The Mankato-North Mankato Metropolitan Statistical Area (MSA) is a vibrant, growing regional center, with a 2019 estimated **population of 101,974**. Drawing from a 6,800 square mile region, retailers here have access to a **primary retail trade are population of 286,810**.

Despite being half the size of other regional centers, we punch above our weight in terms of retail sales. Below is a comparison of Mankato to other Greater Minnesota regional centers. The secret to this regional pull? Geography. Our 6,800 square miles retail trade area is bigger than most regions because of where Mankato is located. Consumers come from across southern Minnesota and northern lowa for shopping.

With nearly \$1.3 billion in gross retail sales, the per capita retail sales is the highest in Greater Minnesota, we are a destination for retail shopping.

Health Care: Regional headquarters for Mayo Clinic Health System and Mankato Clinic. Also home to the renowned Orthopaedic & Fracture Clinic and River's Edge Hospital & Clinic.

Education: Home to five colleges - Bethany Lutheran College, Gustavus Adolphus College, Rasmussen College, South Central College and Minnesota State University, Mankato - with an annual enrollment of more than 25,000 students.

Manufacturing: A hotbed of productivity, with a richly diverse industry make-up and consistently steady growth, contributing to the overall economic strength and stability of the marketplace.

Agribusiness: Magnet of activity for agriculture related businesses, as well as producers who travel many miles to do business in Greater Mankato
