IOCAL TRANSPORTATION SALES TAX OPTION FOR BLUE EARTH COUNTY The Need for More Transportation Funding

Currently, there is a **\$4,223,000** gap in transportation funding for Blue Earth County's 430-mile County State Aid Highway (CSAH) System. Funds are needed to improve the existing County Road system as well as expand infrastructure demands.

BLUE EARTH COUNTY ROAD & BRIDGE FUNDING INDICATORS OF NEED

New MnDOT State Aid for Local Transportation (SALT) formula estimates annual life cycle needs at \$11,023,000 per year for Blue Earth County

(based on extremely conservative life cycles).

\$2,000,000 Road & Bridge Construction Allocation – Local tax \$

COUNTY STATE AID HIGHWAY SYSTEM

430 miles of paved rural and municipal roads (construction and maintenance primarily funded by the Highway User Tax Distribution Fund).

COUNTY ROADS

304 miles with 41 miles of paved and 263 miles of gravel roads (constructed and maintained with local road and bridge property tax funds).

In 2013, the Minnesota Legislature passed legislation (Statute 297A.993) authorizing individual counties to enact new revenue sources to specifically finance transportation projects:

- Sales tax up to 1/2 percent on retail sales
- A wheelage tax of \$10 on vehicles kept in their county
- A \$20 excise tax for retail sales of vehicles

BLUE EARTH COUNTY TRANSPORTATION FUNDING OPTION COMPARISONS (POTENTIAL REVENUE ESTIMATES)

Transportation Sales Tax Revenue Options:

1/2 Cent Sales Tax: \$5,587,738
1/4 Cent Sales Tax: \$2,793,869
\$20 Excise Tax per new vehicle: \$200,000 (Residents, businesses, commuters, visitors share in the cost)

Wheelage Tax Revenue Option:

\$10 per vehicle flat fee: \$505,000 (Blue Earth County licensed vehicles)



Property Tax Levy Revenue Option:

10% levy increase = \$3,000,000 20 % levy increase = \$6,000,000 (Blue Earth County property owners)
