

Kato Public Charter School at a Glance — 2018–2019

Overview

- Opened in September 2000 for grades 7-12
- Expanded to add 6th grade in 2005
- Changed name in 2014 to underscore the **public** nature of KPCS and its role in the community

Immediate Needs

- **School board**
 - One seat is immediately available; others are expected to be open on July 1
 - Board will appoint members short-term, with a special election in the fall
- **Teachers and other instructional staff**
 - Core curriculum: English, math, science, and social studies
Teacher training is preferred but not required; Tier 1 licensure possible with a 4-year degree
 - Special education
 - Paraprofessionals
 - Work-Based Learning Coordinator
- **Leadership**
 - Specific titles and roles are TBD, but responsibilities are generally in the areas of program administration, business management, community outreach, student services, human resources, and curriculum and instruction
 - Instructional Design Coach is a leadership position with specific responsibilities dependent on other staffing and available applicants
